<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of the Men of Music Scholarship is to provide funding for vocal music instruction and vocal music camps to males entering 7th through 12th grade. Students living in Midland, Bay, and Saginaw counties are eligible for the scholarship. The selection of recipient students will be based on academics, school and community involvement, and experience in vocal music performance.

We will award up to one \$1,000 scholarship each year. The money may be used for voice lessons, summer music camps, summer musicals, study materials, travel to performances, and formal apparel. Men of Music will issue a letter to the student and, after receiving information about organization(s) and cost, will send payment(s) directly to the organization(s).

A scholarship committee with representatives from the Men of Music will recommend students eligible for the award each year. Applicants may reapply each year for the award.

Award winners may be asked to take part in a Men of Music performance. Such participation is required.

- 3. Please include the following information about your solo:
 - a. Title of the piece
 - b. Composer
 - c. Your voice part (e.g., tenor)

Please arrange for one letter of recommendation from your choir director or music teacher. You are responsible for seeing that their letter gets submitted by the deadline (**May 31, 2025**) to the Men of Music scholarship chair at menofmusicmi@gmail.com and include the word "SCHOLARSHIP" and your last name in the subject line.

With the exception of the recommendation letter, all application materials should be submitted online to a Dropbox. Every file should include in its title your last name and which part of the application it represents (for example, [your last name]-"Vocal music activities".
